

LIBBY MIDDLE SCHOOL PARENT COUNCIL MEETING NOTES 10/21/13:

1. 11 attended (thank you to all who showed up!!! What a great group of parents and staff!)

2. Fundraiser/community cards: final profit \$1504.25. This money will be used toward bus rentals for January ski day and May 8th grade Silverwood day.

3. Dance Fri, Nov 1st, 3:30-5pm. Helpers are Kim, Missy, Jeana, Star, Joan, Michelle, Jenny, Missy, and Sindy. We will have two parents at the door taking \$2.00 for each student entry. We also will have two parents selling food/drinks. Other parents will roam. Jeralyn will be leading the prize give-away. Kim purchased prizes already. Jeana bought the food/drinks. Kim will bring a cooler with ice for drinks. Michelle is making posters and hanging them on 10/28/13 in LMS hallways. Kim will contact Karen Erickson to put in announcements all next week. Alex Eanes already made up a cd of music we will use. All parents are welcome to show up at any time. The schedule will be: open gym 3:30-4, dance 4-4:45, prize give-away 4:45-5pm. All kids have to take off shoes and wear socks on gym floor. Sindy will bring money. Thanks to Jeana, Michelle, Jeralyn and Sindy for helping get everything ready.

4. January 31st, 2014 Ski Day at Blacktail:

-Volunteers (need around 20), Kim Peck will be asking for volunteers in December. If the parent skis or snowboards, it is \$20 per person for the ticket for the day. If parent needs to rent, rental cost is an additional \$20. Parents can ride the buses over, or drive. If parents drive, the student must ride the bus over and have a note from their parents to ride home with a parent.

-cost for kids \$20 each kid. This includes a two hour lesson and rental and ski ticket for the day. ALL kids will take the lesson. They will group the kids into ability so beginners will

not be with experienced kids. If the student does not need to rent, the cost is still \$20 regardless.

-Kim will contact Ms. Rose in November so the teachers can decide what requirements they will have for the students in order for them to attend.

-scholarships will be available for kids who can not afford to pay; however, we will ask for the student or parent to volunteer to work in our concession stand one day for the free admission.

-kids will bring money or their own food for lunch and dinner. The buses will stop at McDonalds in Kalispell on the way home for those kids wanting to bring money for dinner.
